**A Note On a Teacher's Attitude:**

James wrote that not many of us "should presume to be teachers" (James 3:1) and that teachers will be "judged more harshly." This is basically a warning to remain **humble** and this certainly applies to how we gently teach & share with non-christians.

In John 13, Jesus himself carefully taught his disciples, by washing their feet, that serving was a more true demonstration of love than teaching. In chapter 15, he went a step further, calling them to be friends, not just servants. **And this is exactly the point:** Jesus won the hearts of men by **servng** and by being a **friend**, not by being a legalistic teacher in the mold of the Pharisees.

If we are serious about helping seekers, we must do more than have a conviction about this—we *shouldt excel at being servants and friends to the lost*. Non-christians need trust in **Jesus**, but also in *our friendship* in order to have the courage & faith to make difficult spiritual decisions. May we commit ourselves to earning their trust, not to winning arguments; to giving *inspiration*, not just information.

**Please keep in mind** that people learn better by thinking and answering questions, and not by listening to a teacher explain. Make each study a time for good questions and do not feel the need to explain everything.

The following outlines are meant to be a teacher's aid, and are by no means the only sound list of scriptures to include in conveying gospel basics to unbelievers. They constitute a good way, however, to make sure seekers have enough knowledge to make informed decisions about the lordship of Jesus. Thank you for your service to God in helping to teach others!

Observations:

- A. John 7:30-46 His claims were strange; extraordinary
- B. Some Logic: These amazing claims are either-
1. True-that is, Jesus really is God's Son and **Lord**  
**or**
  2. False-that is, Jesus is *deliberately* telling lies (he's a **Liar**), or  
Jesus is *sincerely* telling lies (he's **Crazy**)
- C. Each possibility-
1. **Jesus is a Liar:**
    - Jews did once call him a "deceiver" (John 7:7-11)
    - Liars have reasonable motives: what's Jesus'?
    - If Jesus was a liar, he was also the ultimate hypocrite-he said, "I tell you the truth," **eighty times** in the gospels.
  2. **Jesus is a Lunatic:**
    - Some said: "he's demon possessed & raving mad." (John 10:19-21)
    - John 8: are lunatics so clever?
    - John 3: Would Nicodemus take a lunatic seriously?
  3. **Jesus is Lord:** John 20:19-31—Thomas' struggle with reason & faith
